The program is designed for health care providers and staff to encourage and help patients eat more fruits and vegetables through the farmer's market and other local resources. Patients who qualify receive a \$20 voucher that can be used at the Antigo Farmer's Market.

Provides \$35 voucher to eligible seniors (age 60 and older) to purchase Wisconsin grown fresh fruits, vegetables, and herbs at approved farmer's markets and roadside stands. Vouchers are given out on a first come, first serve basis from June 1- September 30.

Eligibility:

- resident of Langlade, Lincoln, Marathon, or Wood County
- 60 years or older, or Native American's who are 55 years or older
- has a household income that meets eligibility guidelines

This is a program that provides healthy meals to seniors throughout Langlade County. A \$5 contribution per meal is suggested, but not required. No eligible person will be denied a meal due to an inability to pay.

Eligibility:

- anyone who is 60 years or older and who is homebound (unable to transport themselves or access transportation) due to illness or disability
- a spouse of a person who is eligible for meals on wheels based on the above criteria

Eligibility:

- Individuals 60 years or older who have a household income of \$1,580 or less for a one person household <u>OR</u>
- a household income of \$2,137 or less for a two-person household

- A person with a disability, under age 60, who resides in housing facilities occupied primarily by older individuals at which congregate nutrition services are provided
