Donna noted that we have provided locked bags for medications to Heather's dept.

Meghan Mattek – noted that they have completed surveys to see where there are areas of need, first meeting so wants to learn what we do and what she can help with. Can connect with the Lead of the Recovery Coaching team at Aspirus. Joined also so we can get connected with the school district since there is little school district involvement, and they have been contacting Aspirus. Provided this grant info: Wisconsin Safe & Healthy Schools - School SBIRT - Screening, Brief Intervention and Referral to Treatment (wishschools.org). Suggested adding hygiene items to the Narcan vending machines for children/people in need. Suggested more



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grants for funding issues.

Marnie Schroeder – first meeting, wants to learn how she can help us and partner to see what she can do – services in homes, schools, etc. – they have a different way of interacting with the community/clients than other programs. Working on a medically monitored inpatient treatment program – waiting on DHS to finalize this so they can get it up in running, already have resources and staff. Barriers are lack of therapists, insurance coverages for treatment and funding.

Felicia Schmit – Recovery Coaching for individuals who are having issues with substance use. Anyone can refer to them (DOC, self-referral, ER, jail discharge, etc.). Referrals can be called or emailed (phone 24/7 line 715-424-0403, email

tbrreferral@threebridgesrecoverywi.com). Coaches can go to the hospital to meet in crisis situations within an hour – trying to work more with Aspirus Langlade to utilize this service more. Smart Recovery program, implemented in Wood County, expanding to other counties. Langlade County Jail doesn't have enough room
